Organized by Tim Cox, Aria Hill, Benjamin Sturkie and Pamela Sun, the Architecture Program Lecture Series Committee with coordination from Professor Joseph Bedford

The Fall 2020 Architecture Program Lecture Series in the School of Architecture and Design at Virginia Tech addresses *New Modes of Practice*. We have invited a cohort of young practitioners presently working in new ways in order to question architectural media, representation and the relationship between practice, politics, society and critique to share and discuss their work with us this Fall. Our speakers for the Fall all challenge, in various ways, previous modes of design dominant during the late 1990s and early 2000s that privileged technical mastery over political, social and critical ideas. They each explore alternative sensibilities which seek to reimagine the relationship between new modes of architectural design and their political, social and critical effects.

**Lectures** will take place on **Wednesday evenings, 7-8 PM (EST)**, and will be hosted and moderated by students. Debate, discussion and conversation, will continue in a **special guest seminar** following each lecture typically on **Thursday, 2-3 PM (EST)** (with two exceptions noted above). All lectures and guest seminars will be via Zoom and Zoom links will be circulated by email. All lectures and guest seminars will be recorded and made available at a future date in the semester.
